

Seeds

The set of carbonized seeds, formed mainly of wheat, was collected in the remains of an agricultural unit, dated to the first half of the fifth century, at the foot of the castrum. This form of storage shows a need to protect food resources during a troubled period.

What is carpology?

Carpologists are specialists that study seeds and fruit collected during archaeological operations. They perform botanical identification and sorting of plant remains, based on reference collections. Their analyses contribute to understanding of farming practices, dietary habits and the natural environments inhabited by people.
